

STATEMENT ON ST. ALPHONSUS HIGH SCHOOL

“Cardinal Maida, along with the College of Consultors (the board of priests who advise the archbishop on administrative and financial issues), has accepted the recommendation of the parish council at St. Alphonsus to cease operation of its high school at the end of this current academic year. While recognizing the long and respected tradition of St. Alphonsus, the archdiocese concurs that the parish can no longer sustain the fiscal and academic viability of the school. St. Alphonsus will make every effort to assist students and their parents moving to new school communities in the fall.”
