Tom Rashid to become Associate Director of Michigan High School Athletic Association

After 15 years as Director of the Catholic High School League and of the Office for Health, Athletics and Physical Safety of the Archdiocese of Detroit, Tom Rashid will leave in August to become Associate Director of the Michigan High School Athletic Association (MHSAA) in Lansing.

“It was a difficult decision because of my love for the Catholic League and the many people with whom I have worked,” said Rashid. “However, I will continue to have strong relationships with league principals, athletic directors and coaches and I’m ready for a new challenge in a new position.”

Sister Frances Nadolny, superintendent of schools for the Archdiocese of Detroit, noted that Rashid possessed “unusual integrity, great honesty, a deep sense of fairness, and a commitment to youth.” She added the Catholic League had grown and prospered under his leadership and commended Rashid for “a job well done.”

Rashid will assume his new position on August 4. At that time, Vic Michaels, who has served as Associate Director since 1995, will take over as Director of the Catholic League and the Office for Health, Athletics and Physical Safety.

“Vic has a wide variety of skills and has worked extremely well with Tom,” said Nadolny. “Under his leadership, the proud history of the Catholic High School League is certain to continue!”
