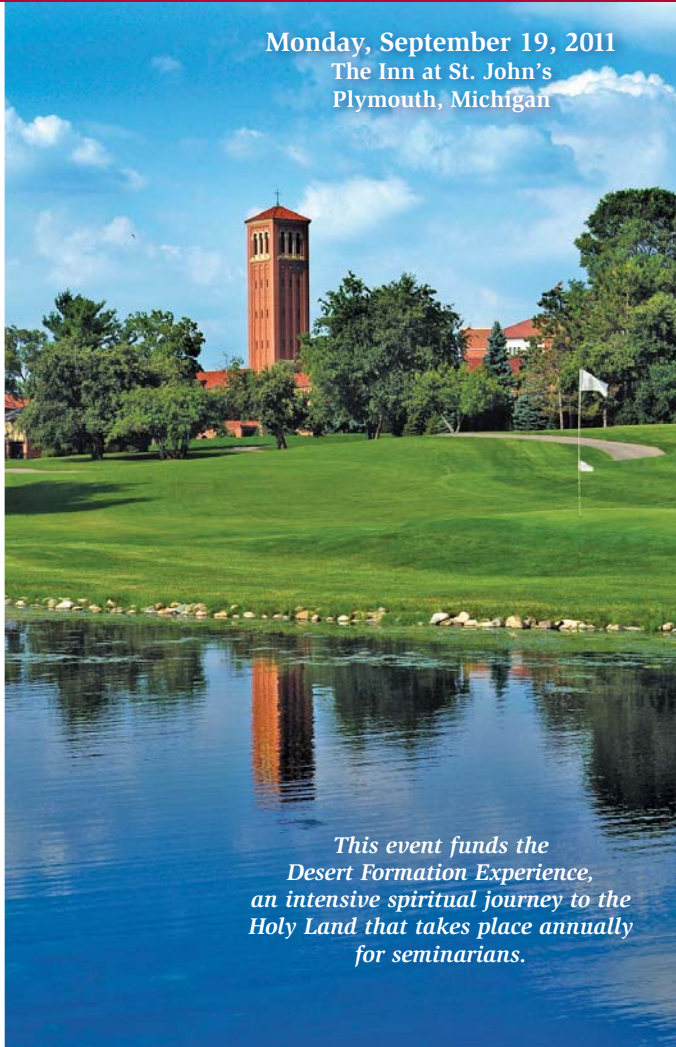

A priest serves as team captain and plays with four golfers in an 18-hole scramble. Golf is followed by a reception and an excellent dinner, giving you time to relax and compare scores with the other players. The evening is topped off with award presentations and the distribution of door prizes.
