Dear Brothers in Christ:

Father Francis H. Maguire, O.P., entered eternal life on Wednesday, April 19, 2006 at the age of 75. May he be at peace with the Lord he loved so well.

Father Maguire was born in East Orange, New Jersey, on August 19, 1930. He entered the Dominican Novitiate at St. Rose Priory in 1950, and was ordained at St. Dominic Church, Washington, DC on June 11, 1957. He last resided at the Mohun Health Care Center in Columbus, Ohio. In addition to his many out-of-state assignments, he was assigned to St. Vincent Ferrer Priory in Madison Heights from 1958-1963; Pastor at St. Dominic Church in Detroit from 1977-1983; St. Dominic Priory in Detroit from 1993-2002; and returned to hospital ministry serving at Providence Hospital, Southfield and Beaumont Hospital, Royal Oak until 2003.

Father was waked at the Mohun Health Care Center in Columbus, OH on Sunday, April 23 and remained there until the Office of the Dead was celebrated in the chapel at 7 p.m. A funeral Mass was celebrated on Monday, April 24 at 11 a.m. at Mohun Hall Chapel.

Funeral arrangements were handled by Egan-Ryan Funeral Home, Columbus, OH. Burial took place at St. Joseph Cemetery, Somerset, OH on April 24 at 2 p.m.
